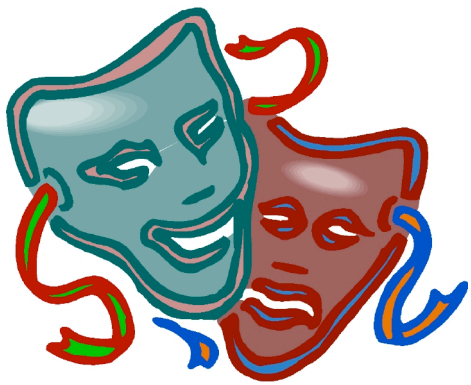

The 2011 Performing Arts Camp is open to students ages 9-18. Space is limited to the first 33 paid applicants. Students will receive instruction in all areas of play production including: basic theatre terminology, stage movement, character development, voice production, singing, dancing, make-up techniques, scene painting, and much more. Student participation in activities will be appropriate to their age and skill level.

This year's production is **Willy Wonka, Jr.** Roald Dahl's timeless story of the world famous candy man and his quest to find an heir comes to life in this stage adaptation of Charlie and The Chocolate Factory, which features the songs from the classic family film "Willy Wonka and the Chocolate Factory." The memorable score features "The Candy Man", "Pure Imagination", "Oompa Loompa" and "I Want it Now" by Academy® and Grammy® award winners Leslie Bricusse and Anthony Newley. There are plenty of roles for boys too! The roles will be assigned after auditions – every child will have a role.

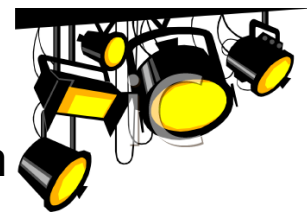

## 2011 Visual and Performing Arts Camps Code of Conduct and Liability Release Form

In order for you to participate in the 2011 Visual and Performing Arts Camps you must read the following information and sign the compliance agreement. This form must be completed and turned in before the start of camp.

**DRESS CODE:** Student will wear the official T-shirts or art aprons every day for class. Shorts are to be modest and neat. Please wear tennis shoes.

**CODE OF CONDUCT:** Any unbecoming conduct shall be subject to the appropriate disciplinary action that is deemed necessary by the instructor. Disciplinary action will involve immediate suspension from the current class activity. Multiple infractions will result in an official written warning and parent consultation and the student will be expelled from the camp. **NO REFUND WILL BE ISSUED** if the student is expelled.

Infractions include, but are not limited to: disrespect to instructors or fellow students, abusive or profane language, disruptive behavior, failure to take care of the facility, non-cooperation, and excessive absences.

**LIABILITY RELEASE:** We the undersigned acknowledge that we have read and understand and accept all terms herein. The Lea County Commission for the Arts and all its members, directors, agents, owner, successor and assignees are free from all liability, claims or other forms of legal action, including costs arising therefrom, against any incident which results or arises out of any loss, property or personal (death included), which may be sustained by the student during travel to, or from the participation in the camps.
